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Year 7 New Starter FAQs

What uniform does my child need, and where can I buy it?

Blazers, skirts, ties and PE kit must be purchased directly from our uniform supplier, Stevensons via their website:

What is Cashless Catering?

Your child can purchase food and drinks in our restaurant using their fingerprint. We will be holding a set up event for this during the summer break, date to be confirmed. Log in details for WisePay, used to top up your child's account, will be sent in September.

Your child can also bring a packed lunch from home, should they prefer.

When will I begin receiving communication from the school?
